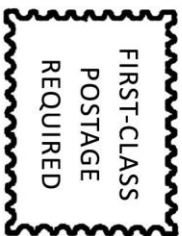
MORE THAN FIRES... SO MUCH MORE

TRAINING TO RESPOND

With so many types of responses, we aim to provide a pretty intensive training program to our newest members. In the first 18 months after joining our department, volunteers will complete coursework in emergency medical care, basic firefighting and hazardous materials response. Although the certifications they earn will be awarded by agencies like the Arkansas Fire Academy and Department of Emergency Management, the vast majority of our training is provided right here in Maumelle.

LEGACY OF SERVICE

What is now the incorporated City of Maumelle was originally protected by a volunteer fire department during the early stages of its development as a planned community in the 1970s. Today, a select group of men and women continue to train and prepare to help neighbors in crisis for little compensation or recognition as volunteers with the modern Maumelle Fire Department.

AN IMPORTANT ROLE

Even with career firefighters on duty, our volunteers are an integral part of the fire department. On alert around the clock, the volunteers are summoned via radio pager an average of three times a week to assist the career staff or to respond in their place if the firefighters on duty are already on the scene of other incidents.

Volunteer firefighters, who are actually paid a small response-based stipend, also commit to attend twice-monthly training meetings to develop their skills relating to the many types of emergencies we're equipped to handle.
